Section 3 Policy Statement and  
Solicitation for Section 3 Businesses

It is the public policy of the City of Bradford to promote the opportunity for full participation by low and very-low income persons and to business concerns which provide economic opportunities to low and very-low income persons for its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Programs. Businesses located in the City of Bradford that are 51% owned by Section 3 residents (a public housing resident or a person whose income does not exceed 80% of median income for this area), who hire at least 30% of their workforce or are willing to subcontract at least 25% of their contract awards to persons who meet the definition of a Section 3 resident or business concern are encouraged to either bid on CDBG and HOME contracts or contact Sara Andrews of the City of Bradford's Office of Economic and Community Development (20 Russell Boulevard, PO Box 490, Bradford, PA 16701) to be added to a list of qualified Section 3 contractors or suppliers.
