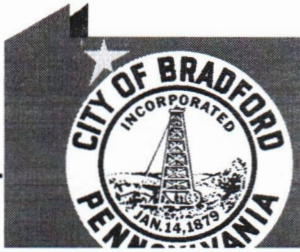

The following are projects accomplished by the department during the month of February 2026:

- (a) Salted and plowed City roads and sidewalks
- (b) Ordered 400 tons of road salt and 25 tons of anti-skid material.
- (c) Removed snow piles from city parking lots.
- (d) Shipped ten pallets of electronic goods to be recycled.
- (e) Responded to 46 PA-1 calls.
- (f) Repaired 3 street signs and straightened 3 signposts.
- (g) Removed snow from both the Downtown and E Main St business districts.
- (h) Pothole patched city roads where necessary.
- (i) Removed fallen trees from Bedford St and Maplewood Ave.
- (j) Repaired city plow trucks as needed, rebuilt two Western snowplows.
- (k) Removed heavy ice buildup from the police station roof.
- (l) Barricade placement as needed.
- (m) Received 25 tons of new cold patch asphalt material.
- (n) Provide dumpster service to OECD for Park St house rehab work.
- (o) Maintain several dirt areas under City responsibility.
- (p) Salt roads and dock areas at the Hefner Reservoir for the Water Authority.
- (q) Install two new garage doors at the DPW complex at Holley Ave.
- (r) Picked up several road kill animals.
- (s) Emptied the Downtown Business District parking meters of coins for the Treasurers office.
- (t) Continue to repair and rebuild dumpsters.
- (u) Salt roads and walks for several water line breaks.
- (v) Aided Electric Dept, Parks Dept, and OECD when needed.



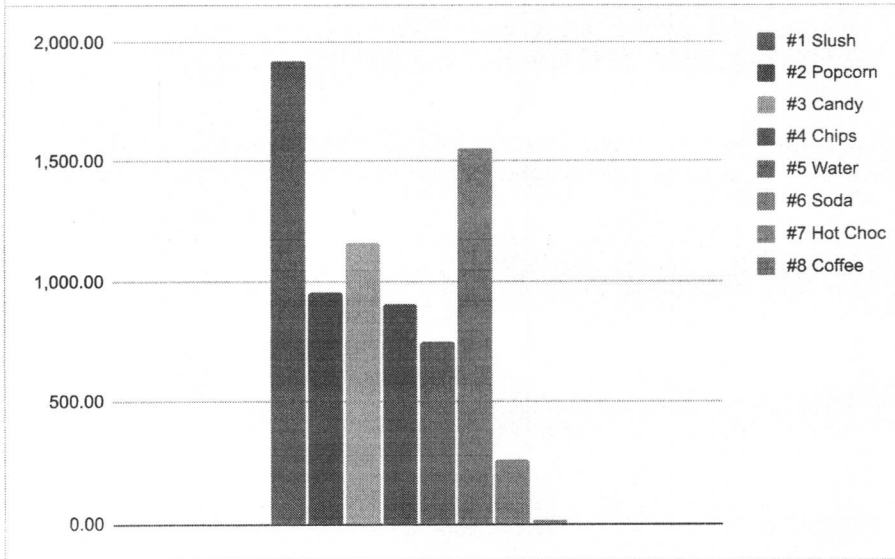

The City of Bradford Department of Property Maintenance and Inspections (DPMI) dealt with a total of 489 activities during the month of February.

Included in that figure, Department personnel responded to a total of 253 violations and performed a total of 121 rental unit inspections/re-inspections at 57 non-owner occupied (rental) properties across the city.

Also, the Department recorded a total of 210 follow-up violations; a total of 44 code officer discovery violations at properties; received a total of 6 complaints from members of the public regarding code violations; and handled 67 other tasks, 1 vehicle issue, 1 sewer issue and 1 visit property.

A total of 2 appeal hearings regarding public nuisance properties were also brought before the Board of Health for action in February. There was also one public nuisance property case that was heard in the McKean County Court of Common Pleas in Smethport.

The Department of Property Maintenance also began receiving back 2026 rental property registration payments and related paperwork on responsible local agents for property owners. The response rate for return of the responsible local agent sheets was between 45 and 50 percent. All rental property owners within the city must register their properties with the Department of Property Maintenance no later than March 31, 2026.
