The City of Bradford Department of Property Maintenance and Inspections (DPMI) dealt with a total of 311 activities during the month of July.

Included in that figure, Department personnel responded to a total of 187 violations and performed a total of 34 rental unit inspections/re-inspections at 18 non-owner occupied (rental) properties across the city.

Also, the Department recorded a total of 111 follow-up violations; a total of 52 code officer discovery violations at properties; received a total of 13 complaints from members of the public regarding code violations; and handled 22 high grass violations, 6 violations regarding trash/debris, 4 vehicle issues, 2 tree issues, 1 painting issue, and 1 tree issue. Department personnel also visited 7 properties to deal with code violations.

Code officers also issued citations to property owners and posted 1 nuisance property as either condemned or Do Not Rent or Occupy. Code officers also attended 7 court hearings.
