- Pads were poured to set bleachers on at the baseball flds in Callahan Park 3 out of the 5 needed were poured, 1 set of bleachers have been placed.

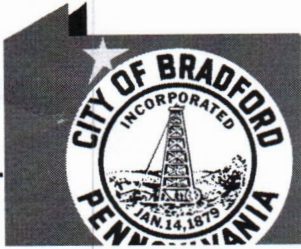

The City of Bradford Department of Property Maintenance and Inspections (DPMI) dealt with a total of 377 activities during the month of May.

Included in that figure, Department personnel handled a total of 216 violations and performed a total of 79 rental unit inspections/re-inspections at 45 non-owner occupied (rental) properties across the city.

Also, the Department recorded a total of 132 follow-up violations; a total of 84 code officer discovery violations at properties; received a total of 12 complaints from members of the public regarding code violations; and handled 10 garbage issues, 3 illegal vehicle cases, 2 grass issues, 1 violation for painting, 1 tree issue, and 1 complaint of fowl being illegally stored on property.

Code officers also took part in one court hearing and posted 3 properties as condemned or do not rent or occupy. The condemned properties were placed on the city's nuisance properties list for possible referral to the Board of Health for action. Meanwhile, one public nuisance property was brought back in front of the Board of Health for a continuation (appeal) hearing.

A handful of citations were drafted and filed against rental property owners who did not comply with the city's ordinances for annual registration of their properties with the Department of Property Maintenance.
